Please complete the enclosed application and return with your deposit by March 5, 2010 to be considered for Africa In April Festival 2010 Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.

Africa In April Festival 2010 will take place at Robert R. Church Park, Beale at Fourth St., in the internationally famous Beale Street Historic District. Hours of operation;

Thursday: April 15th, Vendor's set up day.

Friday: April 16, 7:30am to 8:00pm

Saturday: April 17, 7:30am to 12:00am

Sunday: April 18, 9:00am to 7:00pm

Complete the enclosed application immediately and forward to the Africa In April office. Submitting applications will not necessarily assure your participation. Concessionaires selected will be based on available space, uniqueness, quality and experience. All decisions made regarding participation **ARE FINAL.**

TERMS OF AGREEMENT

1. Location:

Beale Street and Robert R. Church Park, downtown Memphis.

2. Dates:

Vendor set up is Thursday, April 15th, 2010. Friday, April 16th, 2010 thru Sunday, April 18th, 2010. Hours of operation, Friday and Saturday 7:30 am-12midnight and Sunday 9:00am-7:00pm. (**rain or shine**)

3. Booth Rental:

- Concessionaires selected will be based on available space, uniqueness, quality and experience. All decisions made regarding participation **ARE FINAL**.
- Booth assignments and vendor badges will be issued at the time of set-up. **NO** vendor will be allowed to set-up without credentials. Each vendor must show a valid driver's license or other valid government identification in order to pick up badges.
- Once accepted, you will be required to pay your full vendor amount of **\$1,550.00, due March 30th, 2010** (without payment the next person will be offered your spot) (**NO EXCEPTIONS**).
- **No space shall be subleased to another vendor.**

4. Insurance:

Africa In April concessionaires should have liability insurance with a **\$500,000.00 minimum coverage**. Your insurance agent should be able to take care of this for you from your existing policy. **This certificate of insurance you receive from your agent should name the Africa In April, Shelby County and the City of Memphis** as additional insured. **Africa In April will need a copy of the certificate on or before Monday April 10th, 2010.**

5. Permit/Taxes/Licenses:

- Vendor is responsible for all tax liability and licenses due to the City of Memphis, Shelby County Government and the State of Tennessee.
- **Concessionaires must obtain all necessary City of Memphis and Shelby County health permits and tax licenses. Please Call the Africa in April's office for details.**

6. Complimentary Meals:

- All food vendors are required to provide up to but not exceeding **\$125.00** worth of complimentary meals/menu items to AIA staff, and security/law enforcement personnel.
- Coupons will be distributed to staff and security/law enforcement for redemption during the festival. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

7. Menu Criteria:

All participating food vendors must display professional looking menu boards specifying menu items and prices. Menu boards must be displayed at all times. No changes to menu boards will be allowed without prior permission from Africa In April. Africa In April

reserves the right to specify what items, brand names and portion sizes may be sold by vendors, as well as prices vendors may charge for menu items.

8. Non-food items:

- Food vendors will not be allowed to sell any non-food items without the written consent of Africa In April. Use of the “Africa In April Cultural Awareness Festival, Inc.” name, logo, likeness or any other variation thereof, on any signage, T-shirts, printed materials, etc., will not be allowed without written permission from Africa In April.
- All food vendors interested in participating in the 2010 Africa In April Cultural Awareness Festival, Inc. **MUST** submit a completed applications form, a proposed menu with pricing, and a current photograph or layout of their area by the application deadline.
- All food vendors are required to maintain a clean, safe, and sanitary operating environment at all times. After the festival has ended, vendors are required to thoroughly clean their assigned space, dispose of any and all trash, and have the site available for inspection.
